

Legal background: Constitutional reasons

- The former Hungarian constitution and the new Fundamental Statute declared on a fundamental right level the right to support of regular physical exercise and the right to health in Hungary.
- Hungarian state plays a significant role in the support of the health-conscious sport living.
- execution of the 65/1997 (VI.27.) parliamentary resolution about the National Sports Strategy, which help Hungary to become a <u>sport practicing</u> nation instead of <u>sport compeating</u> nation.

- 47,901 Billion HUF in total
- 4,3 Billion HUF for the expenditures of Budapest
- 35,88 Billion HUF for the cost of Puskás Ferenc Stadium
- 118,5 Million HUF for the construction of the giand Diving Tower of Batthyány square

- 2,675 Billion HUF for the canalisation of Margaret Island
- 500 Million HUF for the reconstruction of Margaret Island
- 1,125 Billion HUF for the reconstruction of the Northern part of the quay of Pest
- 400 Million Huf for the construction of a new hoverport in front of Dagály pool

- 24,873 will be in total
- 0,875 Billion HUF will be given for the expenditures of Budapest
- 8,96 Billion HUF will be given for facility development
- 1,206 Billion HUF will be given for the parking development of Balatonfüred
- 357 Million HUF will be given for the support of Balatonfüred

- 1,362 Billion HUF will be given for the reconstruction of Budapest pools (Császár-Komjádi Swimming Pool, Hajós Alfréd Sports Swimming Pool and Széchy Swimming Pool) and the reconstruction of the Balatonfűzfő Swimming Pool
- 655 Million HUF will be given for 'the renovation of some infrastructural part of Budapest'

 399 Million HUF will be given for the construction of the new hoverport in front of Dagály Swimming Pool

- 1,93 Billion HUF will be in total
- It will all be used for the renovation of Dagály plage
